French Knitting (Spool Knitting)

Morning/Afternoon/Evening/Weekend Workshop*



*The workshop time is accommodating to your schedule. It takes approximately 2 hours to begin the technique and organize oneself to a project and the colour/fabric content of the yarn/wool being used.

Once the first class is completed the student takes the work home and tries to complete as much length as possible, on-their-own (one 100 gram ball-Charisma Loops & Threads). Teaching Hands will then support and review progress with an additional hour. This is considered beginner level 1. The corker is locally produced, accommodates a bulky (5) and is sold through Eighth and Mud (alpaca ranch) in Stoney Creek, Ontario.

Corking is now considered to be amongst the home arts to reduce stress related symptoms likely due to its repetitive and rhythmic nature.
